

Special Notice – SCOOTER THEFTS from school



What is happening?

We have sadly become aware that several scooters have been stolen from school grounds in the past month or so. It is not clear exactly what time of day these have gone missing. Some have disappeared over night; others have not been able to be found at 3pm.

What to do if your child's scooter goes missing

If your child's scooter has gone missing, please make sure you let their teacher or the school office know as soon as possible.

Report the theft to the police – then if your scooter is found it can be returned to you.

Where are scooters kept at school?

Scooters have a 'parking place' for each class. These are in view of the classrooms, but are not watched all the time. We remind children to always park their scooter there, and not leave it on the grass somewhere.

What happens if my child forgets their scooter at home time?

Please always take the scooter home if you have brought it to school in the morning.

Come back for it, or ring the office and we can have a look for it.

What is happening about this at school?

We are in discussion with the police about this issue.

We need to get a full list of any missing scooters. If you have not already let us know about a theft please contact us today.

Children are being reminded about where to park their scooters at school, and are being told about the problem.

Usually a teacher will collect a scooter left at school at 3pm and put it into a classroom, but this is not always possible. We will be asking our cleaners (who arrive at school by 3pm) to put any scooters left at the end of the day into a secure classroom.

We have five scooters without owners at the school office – but they do not match the descriptions we have of the stolen property.

If you have a scooter at home that does not belong to your child, please return it to school tomorrow morning. Even if they say their friend has let them use it etc, please send it to school. We know this can sometimes happen.
