Parent-teacher interviews will be held at the following times:

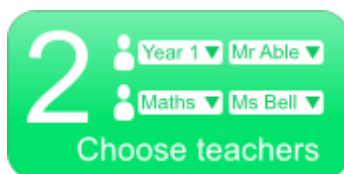
- 3:30pm - 8:00pm Wednesday 03 July

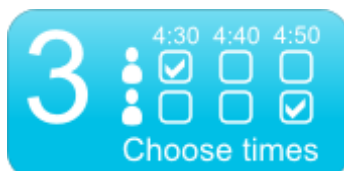
First enter your name, your student's name, and your email address.
