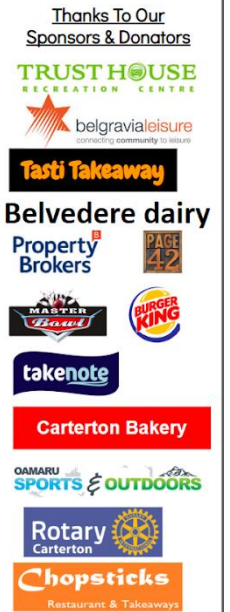
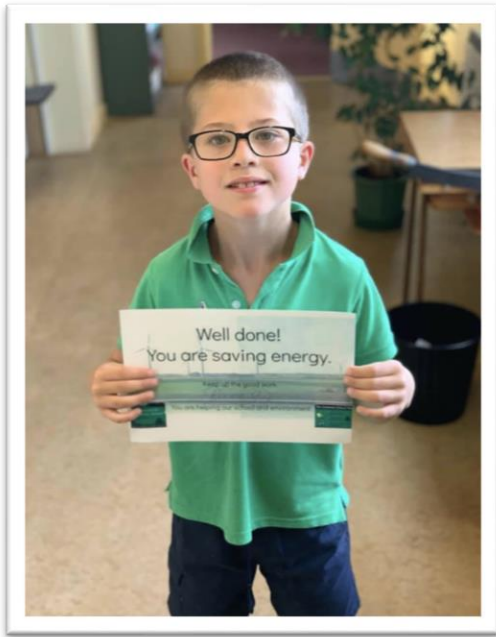
YEARS SEVEN AND EIGHT

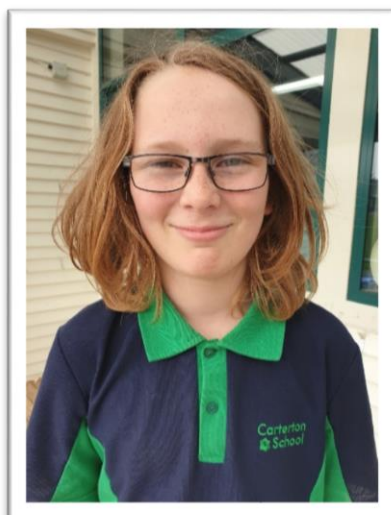
